What is the Intensive English Programme (IEP)?

The Intensive English Programme (IEP) offers English language courses to international (undergraduate and postgraduate) students through the Language Centre of Stellenbosch University. The IEP develops student reading, writing, listening and speaking skills as well as relevant grammar and vocabulary in blocks of eight weeks.

What English language levels are offered?

Beginner, elementary, pre-intermediate, intermediate, upper-intermediate and advanced.

How do I apply?

Read the online Declaration, complete the online 2021 IEP application form and send a copy of the photo page of your passport to Shannon Bishop at sbishop@sun.ac.za.

What is the course schedule?

Classes run from Mondays to Fridays from 09:00 to 12:30 over eight-week blocks. Students are expected to complete an additional hour per day of self-paced activities in preparation for the next day's class.

What are the 2021 course dates?
