Who should apply?

Our IELTS course is aimed at local students, staff and members of the public who need to prepare for the ILETS exam to attend a postgraduate course, or if you need to prove your English proficiency for study, work, or immigration purposes.

What is the course schedule?

The IELTS Preparation Course is presented online for 2 hours, twice a week over 4 to 6 weeks (2 hours per week; 25 hours in total)

Course objectives

This short course is intended to accomplish its goal in 25 contact hours by developing your ability to:

- recognise the format and content of the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) exam, by discussing, practising and analysing each section of the exam.
- improve your test-taking skills and strategies, by completing IELTS-style practice tests in reading, listening, speaking, and writing.
- perform optimally within an academic context, to gain entry into your chosen academic programmes.
- recognise the scoring procedures for the exam, so that you may interpret your own test scores.

Course outcomes

On completion of the course, you will be able to:

- skim and scan academic and authentic texts for general and specific information.
- extract information from and make inferences based on texts of varying lengths, such as university lectures, radio documentaries, radio interviews and conversations.

- interpret and compare data in tables and graphs.
- develop arguments and express opinions on abstract topics.
- provide information in a formal interview context.
- expand academic vocabulary related to common topics such as the environment, science and technology, health, energy, transport, education, the arts, and media.

Are there any course prerequisites?

- You need a minimum B2/Upper-Intermediate English language proficiency level.
- You may need to sit a placement test, prior to the start of the course.
- If you do not have the desired level for entry to the course, we will make recommendations on how to improve your English, so that you may be admitted at a later stage.

What does the course cost?

The cost of the course is R4187 per participant.

We present courses only when a minimum of five paid candidates have been confirmed, hence course dates may change, or a course may be cancelled. In the unlikely event that the Language Centre cancels an IELTS course, you will be refunded in full.
